Addendum – February 2018 : The two fungi species marked in red have been challenged as possible mis-identifications since there are no records at Kew confirming that the species has ever been recorded at Bedgebury. It is not possible for us to confirm or deny the original transect findings at this time, so, rather than deleting part of this transect record, we have chosen to highlight the species challenged so that anyone reading it is aware that its findings may not be accurate.
